

Cornhill Community Action Status report - 7th September 2022

On August 30th, we heard that Steve has been successful in his application for a grant for £10,000 from the National Lottery 'Awards for All'. This means that the joinery and locks can now be ordered.

A trustees' meeting was held on Wednesday 31st August. This was primarily to address the problems David raised at the July CPC meeting. The future of the Cornhill on Tweed Centre (CTC) was discussed and it was suggested that when the units are ready, we will appoint a manager.

At the meeting, Martin reported that both electricity and water had been done as far as SP Energy Networks and Northumbrian Water were concerned. A separate accredited contractor is needed to connect the water the last 3m across the drive and a contract for electrical metering and supply is needed for the electricity.

Two new trustees were appointed:

Chrissy Caley who will represent the Village Hall

Maggie Read who will represent the tenants
